BCRMTA GUIDELINES FOR THE RESUMPTION OF FACE TO FACE LESSONS

This document contains important information about our decision (yours and mine) to resume face to face lessons for either yourself or your child/children in light of the COVID-19 public health crisis. Please read this carefully and let me know if you have any questions.

Resuming Face to Face lessons

We have agreed to restart face to face lessons for yourself and/or your child/children for some or all future lessons. If there is a resurgence of the pandemic or if other health concerns arise, however, we may have to revisit this agreement.

If, at any time, either you or I decide that we would feel safer staying with, or returning to, online lessons, we will respect that decision and move forward on that basis.

We understand that by resuming face to face lessons, we are all assuming the risk of exposure to the coronavirus.

Minimizing Our Exposure

To resume face to face lessons, we all agree to take certain precautions which will help keep everyone (you, me, our families and other clients) safer from exposure, sickness and possible death.

- Students and teacher will only attend lessons if we are symptom free from the coronavirus or any other illnesses
- Lessons will be either online or cancelled should any of us have a temperature of 100 Fahrenheit or more, OR if any of us have any other symptoms.
- Students will wait outside the studio in a designated spot (including your car) until no earlier than 5 minutes before the lesson time
- Students will only bring their designated music books and homework folders into the studio
- Students will wash their hands or use alcohol-based sanitizer when entering the studio
- Students and teachers will wear a mask or faceshield in all areas of the studio. There may be additional barrier devices in the studio such as screens.
- We will maintain 6 feet of distance and there will be no physical contact between us.
- We will avoid touching our face or eyes with our hands. Upon touching our face or eyes, we will immediately sanitize our hands.
- We will take steps between appointments to minimize our exposure to COVID 19

- In the event that any of us become exposed to someone who is infected or could be infected, we will immediately advise each other in order that appropriate precautions can be taken and lessons will return to an online format
- If any of us test positive for the coronavirus, we will immediately notify each other so that appropriate precautions can be taken

The above precautions could change if additional local, provincial or federal orders or guidelines are published. If that happens, we will talk about any necessary changes.

My Commitment to Minimize Exposure

I have taken steps to reduce the risk of spreading the coronavirus within the studio and these efforts are posted outside the studio. Please let me know if you have any questions about these efforts.
